41. Apologies for Absence

- 42. <u>The notes from the last meeting held on 7th November 2017</u>, were considered and agreed as a true and correct record.
 - (a) <u>Oktoberfest</u>

Members noted that this event had been a huge success and had grossed the largest ever value of bar takings at Shotton Hall for a single event.

(b) <u>Remembrance Parade</u>

Members noted that this event went well, with a few minor tweaks to make for next year. Members thanked the Event Coordinator and the Council's Safety Officer for their efforts. It was agreed that the Town Clerk would write to the Police and Church to record the Council's thanks for their support with this event.

44. WWI 100 year festival, DLI Tour November 2018 & Union Flags

Members discussed this item that had been requested by Cllr A Long. It was confirmed that the Deputy Clerk had made contact with the DLI event organisers to investigate options to host the tour in Peterlee. It was agreed that the Town Council should look to place bunting in appropriate places a month before the 100 year festival, subject to a future report to a council committee in due course.
