#### 9. Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were offered and accepted from Councillors S Meikle & K Liddell.

10. <u>Notes from the last meeting held on 26<sup>TH</sup> June 2019</u> were considered and agreed as a true and correct record. It was noted at the recent Community & Environment Committee held on 8<sup>th</sup> July 2019; it had been agreed the Oktoberfest Event be cancelled.

#### 11. <u>Peterlee Show</u>

The Corporate Services Manager advised she had a meeting planned with one of the organisations associated with the event following issues with their members for the past two years. Following discussion it was stressed that PTC would not tolerate bad behavior of any kind and agreed this be relayed to the organisations and the meeting be cancelled and have the event now open for another registered charity to come along to the Carnival and use it as a fund raising opportunity.

It was agreed the policy be reinforced that no staff or councilors and their family members were allowed to enter nay of the competitions over the weekend. It was noted this needed to be reviewed as for the Bogey derby Councillors and staff were allowed to enter but could not win a prize.

It was asked that every effort be made to recycle wherever possible and rubbish be collected in an effort to maximise this.

#### 12. Events

#### (a) Armed Forces Day, 29 June 2019

A Local remember reported he had received a lot of feedback from the event and he suggested that a small working party be established to consider next year's event in detail and this was agreed.

#### (b) Peterlee in Bloom, 15<sup>th</sup> July 2019

It was reported there were finally 16 entries with six of these being new gardens. The judging day had gone well and the presentation event was scheduled for the 25<sup>th</sup> July 2019.

#### (c) <u>Bogey Derby 14<sup>th</sup> September 2019</u>

It was reported there had been 6 entries received so far. It was suggested a small working party meet to consider the details of the event such as parking, entry fee etc.

#### (d) <u>Halloween Event, Shotton Hall, 31<sup>st</sup> October 2019</u>

It was asked that spooky entertainment be sourced for shows to be held in the council chamber for small groups during the event.

#### (e) Remembrance Sunday Parade, 10<sup>th</sup> November 2019

It was mentioned that whoever had volunteered to help assemble everyone at the church would not be able to take part in the Parade itself as they would need to be on site. A running order for the laying of wreaths was to be provided and it was stressed the main objective was to have children at the front of the assembly so that they could see and join in easier.

#### (f) Christmas Tree Lighting, Friday 29<sup>th</sup> November 2019

The Corporate Services Manager confirmed the event will be very similar to 2018's event. The Christmas Market had also been in touch and they could provide 20-40 stalls.

#### 13. Updates on New Ideas

Several ideas were given including a vintage/classic car festival and having market stalls etc. in the trees at Shotton Hall.
