Procurement of Steel Hinged Rugby posts(11m)

Report of:

Report Purpose:

To seek Member approval for the procurement of 11m high steel hinged rugby posts To be supplied and fitted by UKGS at a cots of £975 +vat.

Background:

Following on from my Parks report of 18 January 2016, whereby I was requested by Members to seek professional advice as to gauge the life expectancy of the super heavyweight rugby posts situated on Pitch 2 at Helford Road, I would advise the written Consultant's report concludes that:

- the super heavyweight posts have suffered severe corrosion and that he is unable to endorse the integrity of the existing posts;
- the current posts are beyond economical repair;
- the posts appear to have had a number of repairs, furthermore he concludes that the posts appear to be some 25-30 years old. It would appear that the damage may have been sustained for two reasons: 1) Current height of the posts in excess of 13m and 2) Helford Road area is susceptible to strong Westerly winds which "rock" the posts.

Procurement:

I have produced a standard specification for post replacements which will enable the new posts to be of a hinged assembly type system which will enable the posts to be lowered in high winds, as in a similar type situated at Eden Park (Eden Lane) this system will not only be easier to maintain, but will also significantly reduce the need for manual handling, as this type of post is compatible with the current tractor mounted goal post lowering system currently in use by Parks Department personnel.

I have sought prices from a number of companies who manufacture and supply various sports posts to obtain the best price and after sales service and have received 3 quotes as follows:-

comparisons:

Company A

Rugby Posts + delivery = £975+VAT

Company B

Rugby Posts + delivery = £995+VAT (to be paid up front)

Company C

Rugby Posts + delivery = £1,000+VAT
