47. <u>NORTH BLUNTS LIMITED – UPDATE</u>

The representatives had come along to the meeting to update Members with the proposed development and the planning process. Morrisons were delighted to have been named operator for the site and gave all of the benefits that they as a company would bring to the Town in terms of approximately 350 permanent staff, (full and part time), with local recruitment, Morrison Academy opportunities. They were also the largest provider of apprenticeships schemes in 2011, so they felt that they had a lot to offer the community as an employer and as a store.
